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causes of peripheral arterial disease pad is a form of cardiovascular disease cvd because it affects the blood vessels it's usually caused by a build up of fatty deposits in the walls of the leg arteries the fatty deposits atheroma are made up of cholesterol and other waste substances the build up of fatty deposits on the walls of the arteries makes the arteries narrower and 21 jun 2022 peripheral artery disease also called peripheral arterial disease is a common condition in which narrowed arteries reduce blood flow to the arms or legs in peripheral artery disease pad the legs or arms usually the legs don't receive enough blood flow to keep up with demand this may cause leg pain when walking claudication and other symptoms avoid direct contact with heat for example hot water bottle heat pad showering is possible as the patches are waterproof but patients should avoid soaking in a hot bath sauna or sunbathing if the patient has a persistent temperature of 39 c or above the patch dose may need reviewed use anti pyretic measures symptoms of peripheral neuropathy the main symptoms of peripheral neuropathy can include numbness and tingling in the feet or hands burning stabbing or shooting pain in affected areas loss of balance and coordination muscle weakness especially in the feet these symptoms are usually constant but may come and go 2 jun 2021 the most common symptom of lower extremity peripheral artery disease is painful muscle cramping in the hips thighs or calves when walking climbing stairs or exercising the pain of pad often goes away when you stop exercising although this may take a few minutes working muscles need more blood flow 8 aug 2012 this guideline covers diagnosing and managing peripheral arterial disease pad in people aged 18 and over rapid changes in diagnostic methods endovascular treatments and vascular services associated with new specialties in surgery and interventional radiology have resulted in considerable uncertainty and variation in practice there's no cure for peripheral arterial disease pad but lifestyle changes and medicine can help reduce the symptoms these treatments can also help reduce your risk of developing other types of cardiovascular disease cvd such as coronary heart disease stroke 19 dec 2022 peripheral arterial disease pad in the legs or lower extremities is the narrowing or blockage of the vessels that carry blood from the heart to the legs it is primarily caused by the buildup of fatty plaque in the arteries which is called atherosclerosis pad can happen in any blood vessel but it is more common in the legs than the arms further testing in most cases the gp will be able to confirm a diagnosis of pad by doing a physical examination asking about your symptoms and checking your abpi score there's uncertainty about the diagnosis for example if you have leg pain but your abpi score is normal you do not fit the expected profile of somebody with pad for 21 sep 2015 identifying pad in yourself or a loved one can be difficult since symptoms are often attributed to the normal effects of aging or other pre-existing conditions such as arthritis it's important to realize however that early diagnosis of pad is essential since lifestyle changes and medication can often quickly reduce the pain and discomfort of pad and drastically decrease

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
