**burns and scalds nhs** Dec 30 2022 web burns and scalds are damage to the skin usually caused by heat both are treated in the same way a burn is caused by dry heat by an iron or fire for example a scald is caused by something wet such as hot water or steam burns can be very painful and may cause red or peeling skin blisters swelling white or charred skin
