invertebrate wikipedia 24 sep 2022 web invertebrates vary widely in size from 50 µm to 0.002 m in rotifers to 10 m to 33 ft colossal squid some so called invertebrates such as the tunicata and cephalochordata are more closely related to vertebrates than to other invertebrates this makes the invertebrates paraphyletic so the term has little meaning in taxonomy
